Dear Customer,

Aqua Water Supply Corporation (AWSC), the supplier of potable water to Bastrop County MUD No.1 (BCMUD1), has moved to Stage 1 of their drought management program. As such, BCMUD1 has also moved to Stage 1 effective immediately to help with water conservation.

Stage 1 voluntary watering restrictions limit all outdoor water use, including but not limited to, automatic hose end irrigation, to a **maximum of 2 days per week**, **on assigned watering days**. In addition, outdoor watering should only take place between the hours of **midnight to 10am and from 8pm to midnight**. Please see the watering schedule below and set your controllers for your assigned days and times.

Under Stage 1, the goal is for the district to conserve a minimum of 10% of its normal, non-drought use. Below are some helpful tips to conserve water:

Plant native, drought-tolerant plants

- > They need less water.
- > They require less maintenance and once established, they grow in most conditions as long as they have light.
- > They attract pollinators such as butterflies and bees.

Irrigation system

- Ensure the system is set for the right days and times.
- > Check for leaks and broken sprinkler heads.
- > If you have an electronic water meter, sign up for an EyeOnWater account and set leak alerts.

Check for leaks inside your home

- > Leaking toilets and shower heads can waste between 2,000-20,000 gallons per month depending on the leak.
- Drop food coloring in the back of a toilet tank. If the coloring empties into your toilet bowl after 10-15 minutes, you have a leaky toilet.
