Dear Customer,

Due to high system demand, Aqua Water Supply Corporation has entered Stage 2 of its drought management plan. Bastrop County MUD No.1 purchases drinking water from Aqua WSC and therefore must implement its drought contingency plan accordingly.

Effective immediately, Bastrop County MUD No. 1 is now in Stage 2, which allows a maximum twice per week outdoor irrigation on your designated days and only during the hours of midnight to 10am and 7pm to midnight. Use the schedule below to identify your designated watering days and set your irrigation controllers to accommodate the schedule.

Even number addresses – Monday and/or Thursday
Odd number addresses – Tuesday and/or Friday

Additional Stage 2 Outdoor Watering Restrictions:

1. Use of water for irrigation of landscape areas is limited to the Outdoor Watering Schedule. You may only water using a hand-held hose, hand-held bucket, by drip irrigation, or with a permanently automatic sprinkler system. Watering with hose-end sprinklers is prohibited.
2. Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, etc. is limited to the Outdoor Watering Schedule, except on the premises of a commercial car wash. On private premises, you may only wash vehicles using a hand-held bucket or a hose equipped with a positive shutoff nozzle.
3. Use of water to fill, refill, or add to any indoor or outdoor swimming pool, wading pool, or jacuzzi-type pool is limited to the Outdoor Watering Schedule.
4. Operation of any ornamental fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes is prohibited except where necessary to support aquatic life.
5. The following uses of water are defined as non-essential and are prohibited:
 - Use of water to wash sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts, etc.;
 - Use of water to wash building exteriors or structures, for dust control, to flush gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in any gutter/street;
 - Failure to repair a controllable leak(s) within a reasonable period after receiving notice directing the repair of such leak(s).
